Creating Chapter 3, Part 8 of the Rock County Ordinances
(All-Terrain Vehicles and utility-Terrain Vehicles)

Now therefore be it resolved that the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this Hay of June, 2023 does ordain as follows:

Section 3.8 of the Rock County Code of Ordinances shall be created as follows:

Part 8 - All-Terrain Vehicles and Utility-Terrain Vehicles

- These regulations are adopted under the authority granted by Section 23.33(8)(b), 23.33(11), and 59.02, Wisconsin Statutes.
- (2) Criteria for signage on all-terrain vehicle (ATV) and utility terrain vehicle (UTV) routes on County Trunk Highways is adopted pursuant to Sections 23.33(8)(e) and 86.07(2), Wisconsin Statutes.
- (3) In addition, the provisions of Section 23.33, Wisconsin Statutes, and the provisions of Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 64 regulating all-terrain vehicle operations are hereby adopted.

21 3.802 Purpose and Intent

To create uniform procedures and requirements for the use and operation of ATVs and UTVs on the County Trunk Highway system.

This ordinance is not intended to impede or restrict ATV/UTV use for agricultural purposes outline in Wisconsin Statutes.

3.803 References

Any reference to a Wisconsin Statute or Administrative Code Regulation is a reference to that specific chapter, section, code, or its successor chapter, section, or code. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes or administrative code incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this ordinance to secure uniform regulation of all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles.

37 3.804 Definitions

All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) - shall have the definition given in Wisconsin Statute 340.01(2g)

Applicant - municipal entity requesting consideration for an ATV/UTV route designation on a segment of the county trunk highway system.

ATV/UTV Clubs - shall have the definition given in Wis. Stat. § 23.33(1)(bc)

Municipal Entity - Town, City or Village with jurisdictional area within the borders of Rock County.

Utility-Terrain Vehicle (UTV) - shall have the definition given in Wis. Stat. § 23.33(1)(ng)

53 3.805 Designating ATV/UTV Routes 54 55 The Rock County Public Works Committee may designate ATV/UTV routes following due 56 consideration of the recreational value and after weighting possible risks to public health and safety, terrain involved, traffic density, and history of automobile traffic on potential and 57 58 existing routes. 59 Duties of the Public Works Committee 60 61 62 The Committee shall develop policies and procedures for consideration of, and designation of, ATV/UTV routes in accordance with the requirements of 63 Wisconsin Statute 23.33, Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 64, and the 64 provisions of this Ordinance. 65 66 (B) The Committee shall designate which portions of county highways are 67 ATV/UTV routes. 68 69 70 (C) The Committee shall establish the official ATV/UTV route opening and closing dates for each year. Dates shall be posted on the Rock County website. 71 72 (D) The Committee shall evaluate, annually, all submitted route applications. This 73 evaluation shall consist of consideration of the potential value, efficacy, and 74 75 need for the proposed ATV/UTV routes. 76 **Duties of the Highway Commissioner** 77 78 (A) The Commissioner shall ensure that all routes designated pursuant to this 79 Ordinance are properly posted. 80 81 Application Process for Route Designation 82 83 Any municipal entity in Rock County may apply to the Public Works Committee (A) 84 85 requesting a portion or portions of county highways, within the municipal entity's jurisdictional area, be designated as ATV/UTV routes. 86 87 (B) Applications shall be completed on a form prescribed by the Committee and 88 89 must be in compliance with the policies and procedures developed by the Committee for the designation of ATV/UTV routes. The municipal entity must 90 91 further commit to pay for the cost to make, install, and maintain the necessary 92 ATV/UTV route signage. 93 (C) Application Requirements: An application for designation of an ATV/UTV 94 route, at a minimum, shall include the following: 95 96 97 An application fee, if so required by the Committee. 98 A completed application form. 99 100 A map showing the proposed ATV/UTV route on the county highway 101 102 system. 103 A map showing any existing ATV/UTV routes leading to or are proposed 104 connections to the proposed route. 105 106 A statement explaining why the proposed route should be designated as an 107 ATV/UTV route. 108 109 110 A statement that the applicant will be financially responsible for payments 111 for the installation and maintenance of required ATV/UTV route signs. 112 The municipal entity must provide an approved resolution showing 113 114 adoption of the regulations in section 3.809 of this ordinance for the application to be considered. 115 116 117 3.806 Signage of Routes on County Trunk Highways 118

Any ATV/UTV Route within the limits of Rock County for ATV/UTV use must be posted with

proper signage on a County Trunk Highway prior to use.

121 The municipal entity is responsible for the costs of developing an ATV/UTV route sign plan, 122 and the acquisition/manufacture, installation, and maintenance of the ATV/UTV route signs. 123 124 The ATV/UTV routes signs shall be acquired/made, installed and maintained by the Rock 125 126 County Department of Public Works and the costs will be billed to the appropriate municipal 127 entity. 128 129 3.807 **Routes** 130 No County Trunk Highway may be used as an ATV/UTV route until it has been designated as 131 such by the Public Works Committee and proper signage has been installed in accordance 132 with Wisc. Admin. Code § NR 64.12(7), Wisconsin DNR Guidelines, and the Manual on 133 134 Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), including the Wisconsin Supplement 135 (WMUTCD). 136 The County Board, Public Works Committee, or Highway Commissioner or designee may 137 suspend any route at any time for any reason. 138 139 The Department of Public Works shall maintain a list of approved ATV/UTV routes open for 140 use on the County Trunk Highways with posted speed limits over 35 miles per hour. 141 142 Route Maintenance 143 3.808 144 The designation of County Trunk Highways as an ATV/UTV route does not impose upon the 145 146 County a greater duty of care or responsibility for maintenance of those highways. Operators of ATVs/UTVs on county highways assume all the usual and normal risks of riding that 147 148 vehicle. The County accepts no liability for the operation of ATVs/UTVs on any county highway under this Ordinance. 149 150 151 3.809 Regulation of ATVs/UTVs 152 Except as otherwise provided herein, the statutory provisions of Wisconsin Statute 23.33 and 153 Wis. Admin. Code § NR 64, which create, describe, and define regulations with respect to 154 ATVs and UTVs, are adopted and, by reference, made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set 155 forth herein. 156 157 Operator and Rider Requirements: Any person who operates or rides as a passenger on 158 159 an ATV or UTV on a County Trunk Highway that is an ATV/UTV route in Rock County designated pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 23.33(8)(b)1, must meet the following 160 161 requirements: 162 (A) Any operator or passenger shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws, 163 orders, regulations, restrictions, and rules, including those outlined in Wis. Stat. 164 § 23.33 and Wis. Admin. Code § NR 64. All ATV/UTV rules of operation 165 outlined in Wis. Stat. § 23.33 and Wis. Admin. Code § NR 64 are adopted and 166 incorporated in this Ordinance. 167 168 169 (B) No person may operate an ATV or UTV without having attained the age of 16. 170 No person may operate an ATV or UTV without either a valid Wisconsin driver's (C) 171 license or a valid ATV Safety Certificate issued by the State of Wisconsin. 172 173 (D) Operators and passengers under the age of 18 are required to wear a minimum 174 DOT approved ATV or motorcycle helmet with the chin strap properly fastened. 175 176 177 (E) Operators shall have a liability insurance policy in force on any ATV or UTV operated on an ATV/UTV route. The liability insurance policy must have the 178 179 following minimum coverages: 180 181 1. \$10,000 for property damage 182

\$50,000 for the injury or death of more than one person
