Awarding the Contract for the Installation of an In-Building Distributed Antenna System at Law Enforcement Services (LES)/Jail

WHEREAS, funds were budgeted in the LES/Jail project for the installation of this in-building distributed antenna system (DAS); and

WHEREAS, this allows cell phone coverage within the Law Enforcement Services/Jail building for the Sheriff's Office staff; and

WHEREAS, as part of the security measures being implemented, it is vital to have cell phone coverage throughout the LES/Jail; and

WHEREAS, currently most of the Sheriff's Office building cell phone coverage has little to no signal; and

WHEREAS, this antenna system will provide the needed signal throughout the LES/Jail building; and

WHEREAS, specifications were drafted, and bids solicited with one qualified contractors responding. The lowest most responsive and responsible bidder was Communications Cabling & Network out of Brookfield, WI in the amount of \$153,301.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled on this 28th day of September, 2023 does hereby approve and authorize awarding a contract in the amount of \$153,301 to Communications Cabling & Network out of Brookfield, WI.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a \$15,000.00 contingency will also be approved to cover any possible unforeseen items.

This project is being funded by a combination of sales tax revenue and debt issues.
