Accepting the Public Health Vending Machine Grant and Amending the Sheriff's Office Budget

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded a \$45,000 Public Health Vending Machine Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Human Services for the purpose of purchasing vending machine Narcan; and,

WHEREAS, As of December 6, 2022, the Sheriff's Office installed a Narcan vending machine which is located in the front lobby of the Sheriff's Office. The lobby is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, making the Narcan vending machine available to all individuals at no cost to them, removing any barriers of accessibility to all members of the community ; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant funding is to continue to stock the existing Narcan vending machine at the Sheriff's Office, and to make Narcan free and readily available to the community members of Rock County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 28th day of September, 2023 to approve and authorize the acceptance of \$45,000 of Public Health Vending Machine Grant funds and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office 2023 budget be amended as follows:
