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## Our Purpose:

Family Team Meetings (FTM) works to develop a consistent and structured way to engage with the families using the wraparound approach. FTM helps families by providing a neutral facilitator to help develop a strength-based, family led team of professional and natural supports to assist them in reaching their full desired potential as a family.

## Criteria:

Families eligible for FTM have to be involved with Rock County Child Protective Services. Most commonly, kids in out-of-home placement or at high risk of removal. Referrals can also be made for cases with an In-Home CHIPS or IDA's.

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## Wraparound Process:

**PHASE 1 - Initial Contact and Assessment:** FTM facilitator will meet with the family to explain FTM and engage with them. The facilitator will then help the family choose their team and get the Team ROI signed.

**PHASE 2 - Planning Phase:** The facilitator coordinates and holds the first meeting. The team works together to meet immediate needs and help create Plan of Care unique to the family.

**PHASE 3 - Monitoring Phase:** The FTM team will continue to support one another in meeting goals per the Plan of Care. They will work on tasks and objectives in bite-sized pieces towards larger goals.

**PHASE 4 - Transition Phase:** The family is ready to take on challenges themselves! They feel they have the voice, ownership and choice in their life and services. Typically occurs at the end of their CPS case. CELEBRATE!
