Infection Control Corner

Winter hand hygiene tips:

While hand hygiene is very important, frequent hand hygiene plus cold, winter months often results in dry hands. Many of us wash our hands so frequently this can result in cracked, dry and irritated hands. Did you know broken skin, including dry, itchy skin, is likely to have more germs, and more of the kinds of germs that can cause harm.

Often times, because hands are so sensitive from washing, some may choose not to fully wash their hands to remove germs which means not washing the full 20 seconds or applying enough soap. To decrease the pain, irritation or excessive drying of cleaning hands during winter months, here are some tips:

- 1. Apply lotion or creams to hands overnight while sleeping
- 2. Pat hands dry vs rubbing with friction after hand washing
- 3. Try not to use water that is too hot when washing hands
- 4. Drinking water will provide skin with adequate hydration
- 5. If frequently cleaning hands, hand sanitizer is preferred but can be more drying due to alcohol content

We have two birthdays in the Finance Department this month.






