

2025 Budget & Department Gap Analysis

- 2025 budget constraints are significant
 - Zero percent increase for Rock-IT budget
 - Ruthless prioritization within Rock-IT budget process
- Conducted Gap Analysis
 - Results demonstrated weakness with Tier 3 support and Cyber Analyst Capacity
- A couple of gaps have emerged that will be prioritized in '25 budget
 - Security analyst capacity/ Public Safety Systems capacity
 - Systems administration Tier 3 capabilities
 - Various Security considerations and modernization of applications/ software
