#### **ADMINISTRATIVE NOTE:**

This would be an eligible use in accordance with ARPA rules that allow funds to be provided to entities that suffered losses due to the pandemic, similar to how funds were used for the Small Business and Nonprofit Grant Fund. KANDU would have to provide documentation supporting their losses (decreased revenue and/or increased expenditures) consistent with the amount provided. As there are now several ARPA resolutions that have been introduced that intend to use the same funding source, the County Board will need to prioritize the limited remaining funds if and when this and the other resolutions make it on to a County Board agenda.

### **Human Services Board**
