County H STH 11 - USH 14

September 10, 2024 Town of Janesville Town Hall

Welcome to the public involvement meeting for the proposed improvements to County H. The purpose of tonight's meeting is to familiarize you with the details of the project and seek your input on the proposed improvements. We encourage you to review the project handout and exhibits on display and direct questions or comments to any of the project representatives. We also encourage you to provide written comments regarding the proposed improvements utilizing the attached form.

Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the project is to enhance the safety and quality of County H within the project limits by rehabilitating the roadway surface and pavement structure, widening the shoulder to current standards, updating the CTH H & CTH A intersection, and replacing guard rails and culvert pipes. The existing asphalt pavement was last improved in 2008.



Proposed Improvements

The project is located on County H between STH 11 and USH 14. The proposed project will improve the roadway profile to increase sight distance and widen the shoulder width to meet current standards. The project will also include intersection improvements, curb and gutter placement, culvert pipe replacements, ditching adjustments, beam guard replacement, signing, pavement marking, and restoration.

Traffic Control

During construction, the project area will be closed to through traffic. A signed detour will be posted, and is anticipated to utilize STH 11, STH 213, CTH M, and USH 14. Local access will be maintained for businesses and residents for the duration of the project, including services such as mail delivery and garbage pickup.

Right of Way

Acquisition of additional highway right-of-way is anticipated. The current right-of-way typically varies from 66 to 120 feet wide. The proposed typical section for the roadway would require additional right-of-way throughout the project. The additional right-ofway is necessary to bring the roadway up to current standards and to improve substandard drainage. Temporary Limited Easements (TLE) will also be necessary in some locations for additional slope grading and/or ditching improvements.
