Question 1: INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO \$151,800,000. BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$151,800,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a building and improvement program consisting of: District-wide building renovation, site improvements, safety and security updates, capital improvements, HVAC systems upgrades, Americans with Disabilities Act updates, special education support spaces; and acquisition of related fixtures, furnishings and equipment.

Question 2: RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP COMMENCING WITH THE 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR BY AN AMOUNT OF \$14,500,000. BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin, that the final school district budget shall include an amount not to exceed \$14,500,000 in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes each year for a period of two years on a non-recurring basis, beginning with the 2025-26 school year and ending with the 2026-27 school year, for the purpose of paying the costs of maintaining District class size, student program options and services.
