### **Authorizing Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement - County Trunk Highway G and Afton Road, City of Janesville**

1 **WHEREAS**, the functional/jurisdictional relationship of present County and Local Highway Systems  
2 have been cooperatively reviewed by the City of Janesville and Rock County; and,  
3  
4 **WHEREAS**, Rock County and the City of Janesville have cooperated in developing this jurisdictional  
5 change; and,  
6  
7 **WHEREAS**, Section 83.025(1)(a), Wis Stats, allows the County Board to make changes to the County  
8 Trunk Highway system with the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and the  
9 governing body of the community in which the proposed changes are located.

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly  
12 assembled this 26th day of September, 2024 does hereby authorize the addition/removal of the following  
13 segments from the County Trunk Highway system and transfer to the City of Janesville:  
14  
15 Addition: Existing Afton Road from a point directly under S. Crosby Avenue (Bellrichard Bridge)  
16 northeasterly approximately 0.66 miles to a point at the intersection of Rockport Road.  
17  
18 Removal: Existing CTH G (Beloit Avenue) from a point at the intersection of STH 11 Bypass  
19 northerly approximately 0.58 miles to a point approximately 1,000 feet north of Venture Drive.  
20  
21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors authorizes the County  
22 Board Chair to execute the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement with the City of Janesville.
