SPONSOR

Seeking Support from the State of Wisconsin in the Next Biennial Budget for a Commuter and/or Passenger Rail Study with a Designated Corridor to Include Rock County

WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors, through a series of related Resolutions (R-2022-82, R-2023-189 and R-2024-397), has authorized the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee on Passenger Rail Development (Ad Hoc Committee) to investigate and explore various commuter and/or passenger rail related opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, since its formation the Ad Hoc Committee has regularly met, researched and engaged with individuals and groups that have provided valuable information and insights concerning the possible paths forward to establishing connectivity(s) to said regional Amtrak and/or Metra service opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, this due diligence has identified various potential funding avenues for the development of commuter and/or passenger rail planning efforts and their related implementation activities; and,

WHEREAS, any planning and implementation funding applications will be highly competitive and will require strong support from a diverse coalition of communities, elected officials, regional stakeholders and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, any successful funding application will rely heavily on current and quantifiable data (i.e. a rail study) so support said rail service; and,

WHEREAS, a series of commuter transportation studies, that originally focused on the feasibility of providing commuter and/or passenger rail service into Rock County are either outdated and/or not detailed enough to meet the needs of said funding sources; and,

WHEREAS, absent a current and detailed rail study, it will be extremely challenging to receive the appropriate level of recognition from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's Rail Plan – which serves as the key budgeting, infrastructure and planning investment roadmap for commuter and/or passenger rail services throughout Wisconsin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 10th day of October 2024, does hereby grant the authority to the County Administrator or its designee to formally request support from Governor Evers' 2025-2027 Biennial Budget to fund an updated and detailed rail study that will assist with positioning and planning Rock County for future commuter and/or passenger rail service; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Administration and/or its designee is also authorized to seek support for this request from other applicable public and/or private sector stakeholders.

FISCAL NOTE:

There is no direct fiscal impact to Rock County to authorize the County Administrator or designee to formally request funding from Governor Evers in the 2025-2027 budget. The intent of the resolution is to request the state include funding for a study in their biennial budget, which will benefit Rock County and the communities within it.
