Awarding Contract for Birth to Three Services

WHEREAS, Rock County requested proposals from qualified vendors to provide Birth to Three 1

- Services for children and families under Wisconsin Department of Health Services Chapter 90; and, 2
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 - WHEREAS, the current vendor, United Cerebral Palsy of Greater Dane Co, Janesville, Wisconsin was
- the sole entity that submitted a proposal for services for three-year minimum contracting period with 5
- optional one-year extensions up to five years; and, 6

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- WHEREAS, the United Cerebral Palsy, Birth to Three proposal was reviewed by a four-member panel,
- 9 which included internal reviewers, and it met the specifications of the RFP for Birth to Three Services;

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- WHEREAS, Birth to Three Services are a mandatory component of the Department's strategy to provide essential Service Coordination, Early Intervention and Therapy Service to children and families
